VACCINATED

Who is considered vaccinated?

People who have been vaccinated with a COVID-19 vaccine approved in the EU and who have passed at least 14 days after the last dose of the vaccine. Depending on the vaccine, one (vector-based vaccine COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen from Janssen-Cilag International) or two vaccine doses (vector-based vaccine Vaxzevria from AstraZeneca and mRNA vaccine Spikevax from Moderna or Comirnaty from BioNTech, including heterologous vaccination schedule). A current list of COVID-19 vaccines approved in the EU as well as information on the required number of vaccination doses can be found on the PEI website:

Requirements: Presentation of a valid vaccination certificate, digital (e.g. Corona App) or analog (vaccination card)

RECOVERED

Who is considered recovered?

People who have had a confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection less than 6 months ago. Evidence of a confirmed infection must be provided by direct pathogen detection (PCR) at the time of infection.

Requirement: Submission of the following documents:

- PCR results from a laboratory
- PCR results from a doctor
- PCR results from a test site or test center
- Medical certificate (if the certificate contains information on the test type (PCR) and test date)
- the segregation certificate (if this contains information on the test type (PCR) and test / registration date)
- Further certificates from authorities (if these contain information on test type (PCR) and test / notification date)

TESTED

Which tests are valid?

Rapid antigen test:

The negative test result of a quick test is valid for a maximum of 24 hours, i.e. guests of the Munich Show are given access to the exhibition grounds for one day

PCR Test:

The negative test result of a PCR test is valid for a maximum of 48 hours, i.e. guests of the Munichshow are granted access to the exhibition grounds for two days.

How does the 3G-Check work on site?

Vaccinated or recovered:

The trade fair visitors, exhibitors, and employees receive a colored ribbon from us that identifies them as vaccinated or recovered. Masks are still required in the exhibition halls.

Tested:

The trade fair visitors, exhibitors, and employees receive from us a colored ribbon with the date imprinted, which identifies them as tested for the day in question. Masks are still required in the exhibition halls.

Test possibilities

Important: There is NO possibility of testing on site at the fair!

Please come to the trade fair already with a certificate of the test.

Exceptions:

1. Individuals who have been vaccinated once, have had a PCR-confirmed SARS-CoV-2 infection after the first vaccine dose and have received another dose of vaccine.
2. People who have been vaccinated once and have had SARS-CoV-2 infection less than 6 months ago after the first vaccine dose. The infection must be detected by direct pathogen detection (PCR) at the time of infection.
3. School students count automatically as tested
4. Any medical reasons why a mask can't be worn need verification by a doctor

Requirements: Presentation of a valid vaccination certificate, digital (e.g. Corona App) or analogue (vaccination card) + health certificate, see above.
